However, when customers come to implement SAP supply chain projects, there is often no targeted consulting available to support them.


5 Reasons to choose Körber








2. Industry-specific expertise

3. Migration to the new SAP standard solutions

SAP has announced the end of support for their SAP ERP (ECC), SAP WM and SAP LE-TRA solutions by 2027. As a result, customers have to migrate to current SAP EWM and SAP TM applications and also migrate the underlying ERP to SAP S/4HANA, all in the next few years.


There are a multitude of ways to accomplish these migrations, including using different architectures for SAP EWM (centralized or decentralized to SAP S/4HANA) or migrating to SAP EWM and/or SAP TM before or after migrating the ERP to SAP S/4HANA.



Larger warehouses are often highly automated in order to increase efficiencies and reduce errors. SAP EWM already includes a warehouse control component, called SAP MFS (Material Flow System). It can optimize automatic storage and conveyor technology systems, transport routes, interleaving, and dynamic transport destination allocation.
